

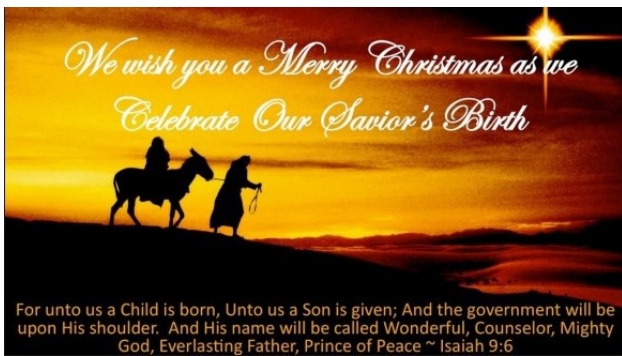
Our Lady of Kāpiti School

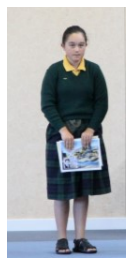
